Almost Heaven 2011 softball rules & regulations

- 15 player roster due to me by 15 July 11.
- At a minimum 8 players must be turned in, No more than 15 players on each roster. Please use the below roster and e-mail to me by the above suspense.
- Team Captain meeting on 14 August 2011 at 1630 hrs. Location: Behind home plate at Power Park.
- Three innings or 30 minutes will be played on each consolation game. Championship game will be 5 innings if time permits.
- Single elimination tournament.
- 5 females must be on the playing field at all times. Note: Regions may play more females at any given time; at a minimum five must play.
- Regions must have a minimum of 8 players to start. Four must be females.
- In the event of batting around, regions will only bat 10 per inning or 12 if AH is used per inning on each game to include the championship game.
- **No grace period is authorized. All teams should report one-hour prior to scheduled game time. Game time is forfeit time.**
- Substitutions will be given to the umpire and official scorekeeper.
- 30 minutes prior to your game time, batting rosters will be distributed to the announcers booth and official score keeper.
- No alcohol or liquor allowed on the field or dugout area. If found by the umpire staff that particular team will forfeit.
- No smoking on the field or dugout area.
- Warm ups will be conducted prior to your game time.
- 1 foul after two strikes is an out.
- Coin flip prior to each game will determine the home team.
- Balls/Bats will be provided for the tournament. Note: We will have additional gloves on hand for any regions that are short.
- Pitchers are allowed 4 warm ups to start, and 2 each ½ innings.
- 1 STRIKE, 1 BALL COUNT ON EVERY AT BAT DURING THIS TOURNEY.
- Courtesy runner in effect only if player is injured during that particular at bat. **Note:** Courtesy runner must be of the same sex. (Last out)
- Regions can utilize the AH rule and bat 12 players during each game. Note: A female AH player does not constitute 5 players on the field at all times.



- **NO STEEL CLEATS & ALL RULES ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED**
- If a player is ejected he/she will set out the entire night. No exceptions!!!
- **AWARDS:** 15 individual trophies will be given to the champions and runner-up at the conclusion of the tournament.
- The batting order may not exceed twelve (12) players and must list men and women separately and followed alternately such that two batters of the same sex may never bat consecutively.
- Players Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced before, during, and after each game. Your team's presence at any game is your acknowledgment.
- A player, coach, or official, who is bleeding, or who has an open wound, or has blood on his/her body or clothing, shall be prohibited from participating further in the game, until appropriate treatment has been administered.
- If first aid is required for a player, the player must be removed from the playing field immediately, unless treatment can be administered in a responsible amount of time.
- A player, coach, or official will not be allowed to participate unless:
 - a. All bleeding has stopped.
 - b. Bloody clothing is removed.
 - c. Any exposed cut/scrape, which has bled, is completely covered.
 - d. **Aid Station will be briefed during coin flip.**
- Teams are encouraged to have spare clothing/jerseys available at the game site to be used, if necessary.
- **In the event of a tie game;** the team captain will select one female from each team. The home plate umpire will then place the female behind home plate. The female will throw/roll a softball toward third base foul line. The female that throws or rolls the softball the farthest and in closest proximity to the foul line will win the tie breaker throw. That team will then advance to the next bracket game.
- Game times are already attached to rules and regulations for each region.
- If a pitcher walks a male batter, the batter takes two-bases. If there are two outs when this walk occurs, the female batter up next can take a walk instead of batting if she chooses.
- No restrictions on where the team captain places each female within the playing field, as long as the minimum requirements of female players are met within each inning of play.
- Teams are strongly encouraged to keep track of runs scored per inning, and checked after each ½ inning with the official scorekeeper.
